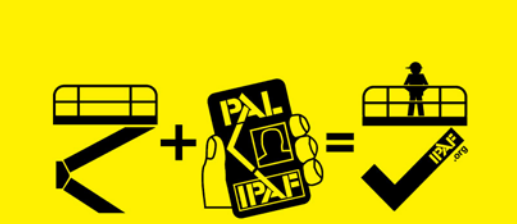

2012 preliminary data has been updated following the reporting of a previously unrecorded fatal incident in Canada in October 2012.

A worker who was stood near a MEWP was pinned against a fence by the basket of a mobile boom when it moved unexpectedly

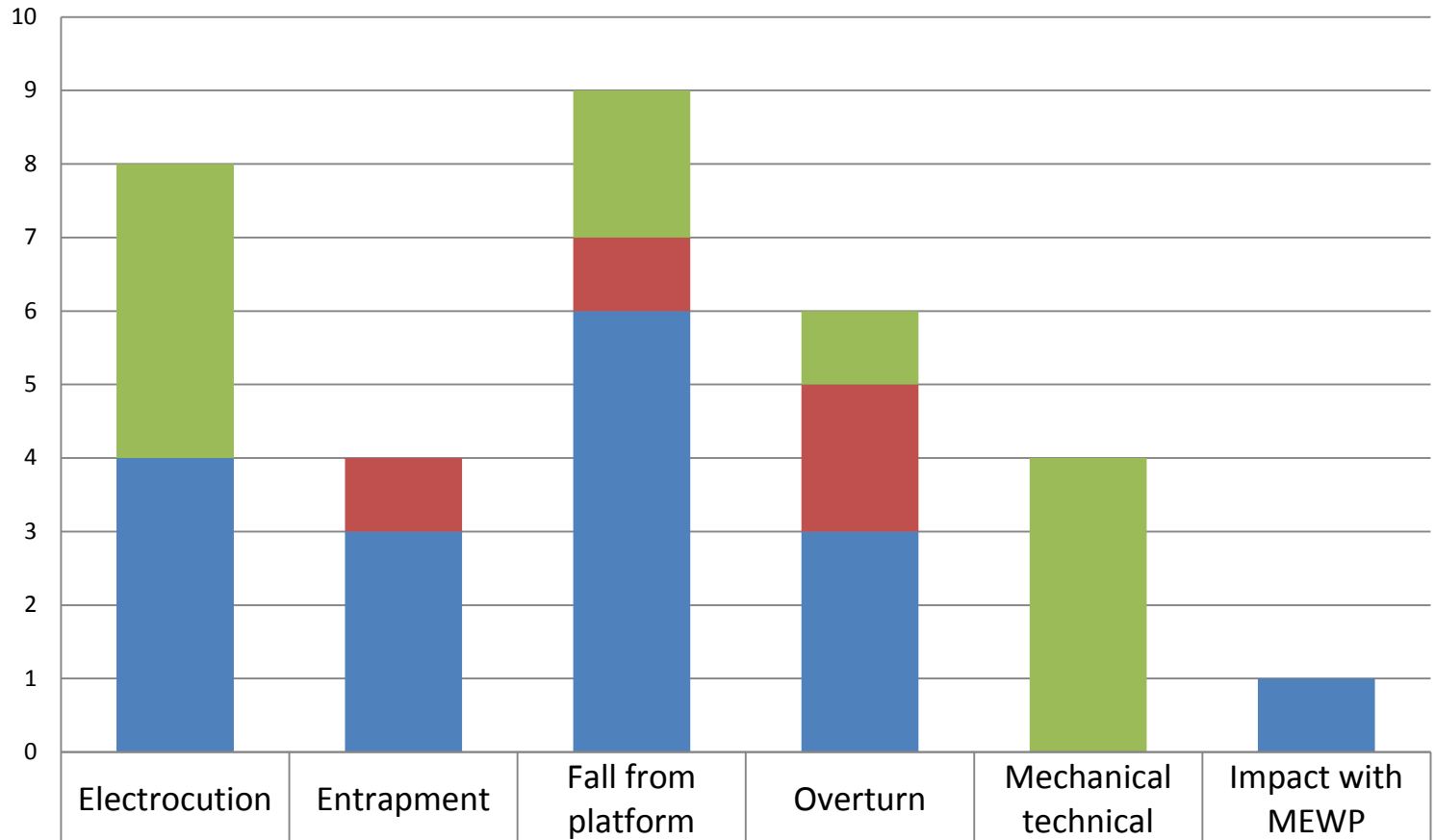
The following two slides show amended 2012 data to take account of the above fatal incident.

Note: All data reflects the number of MEWP related fatalities not the number of MEWP related fatal incidents - some incidents have resulted in more than one fatality.

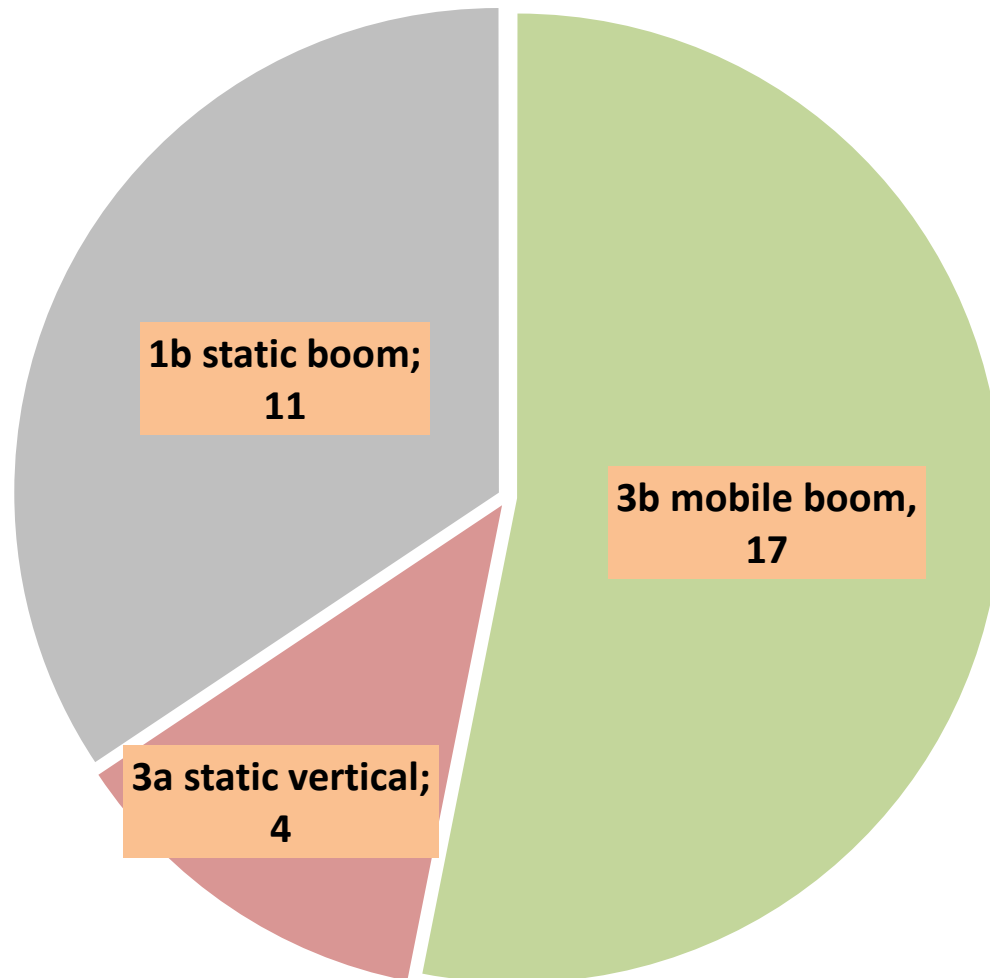

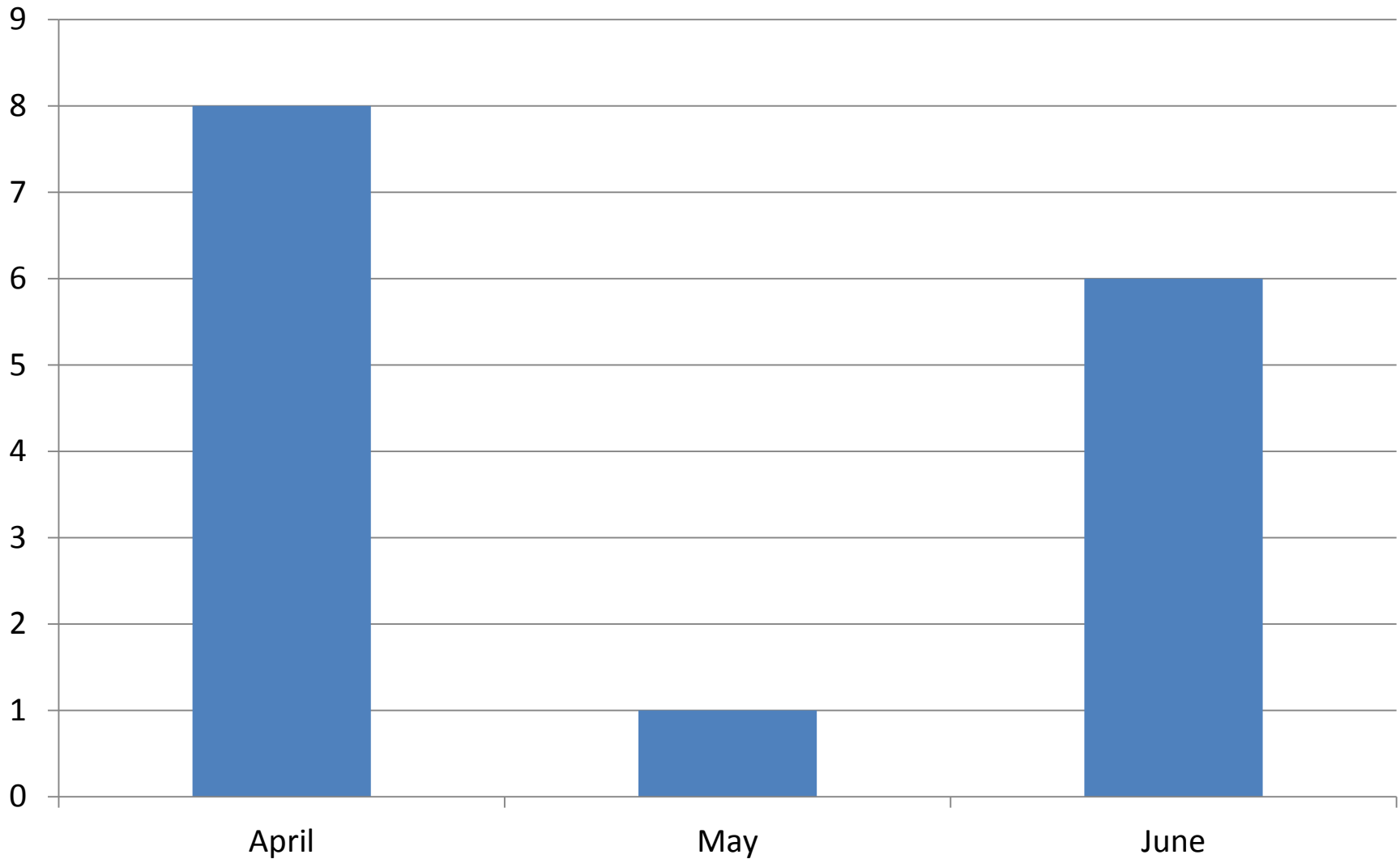

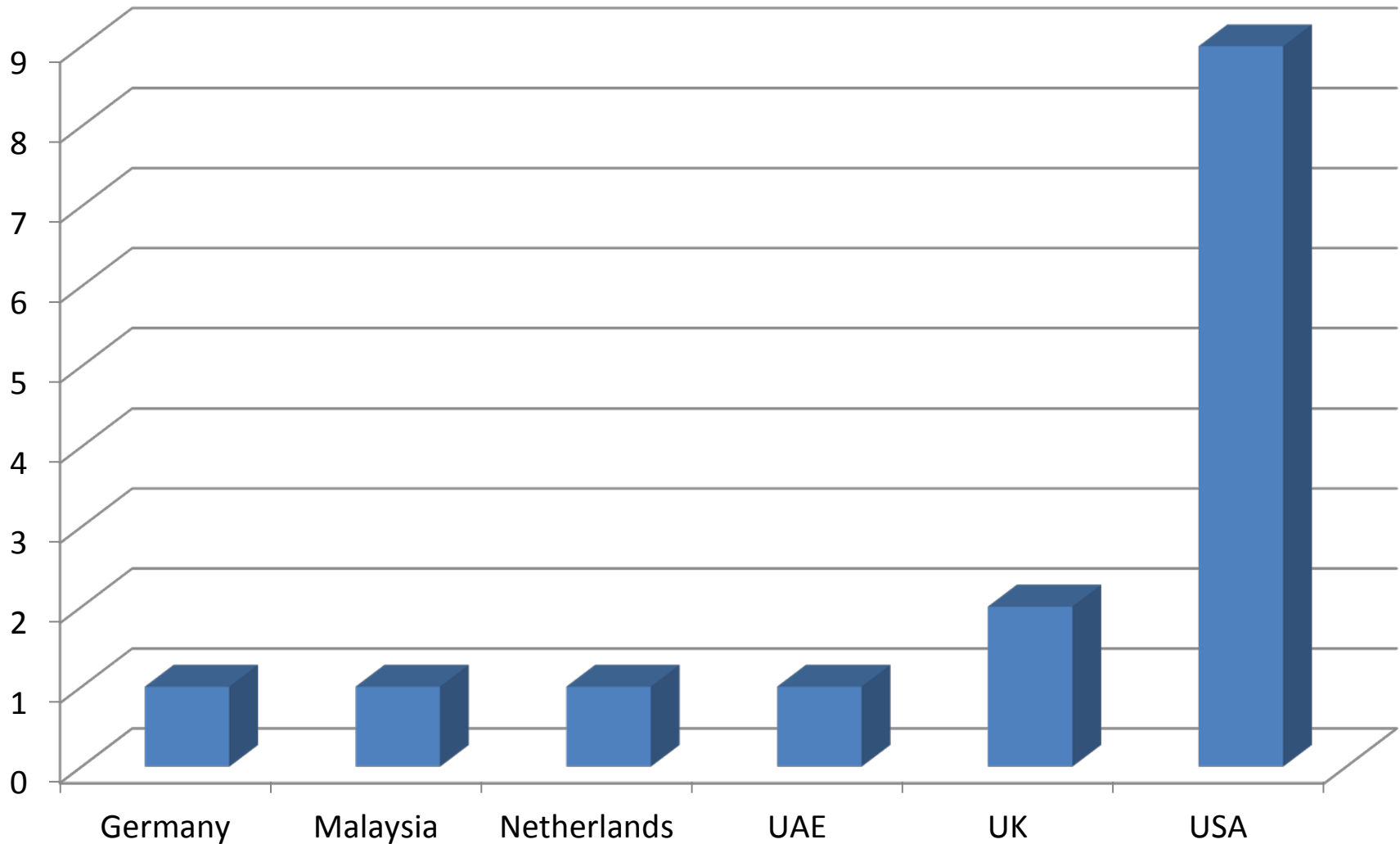

Fatalities 2013 Q2 per country



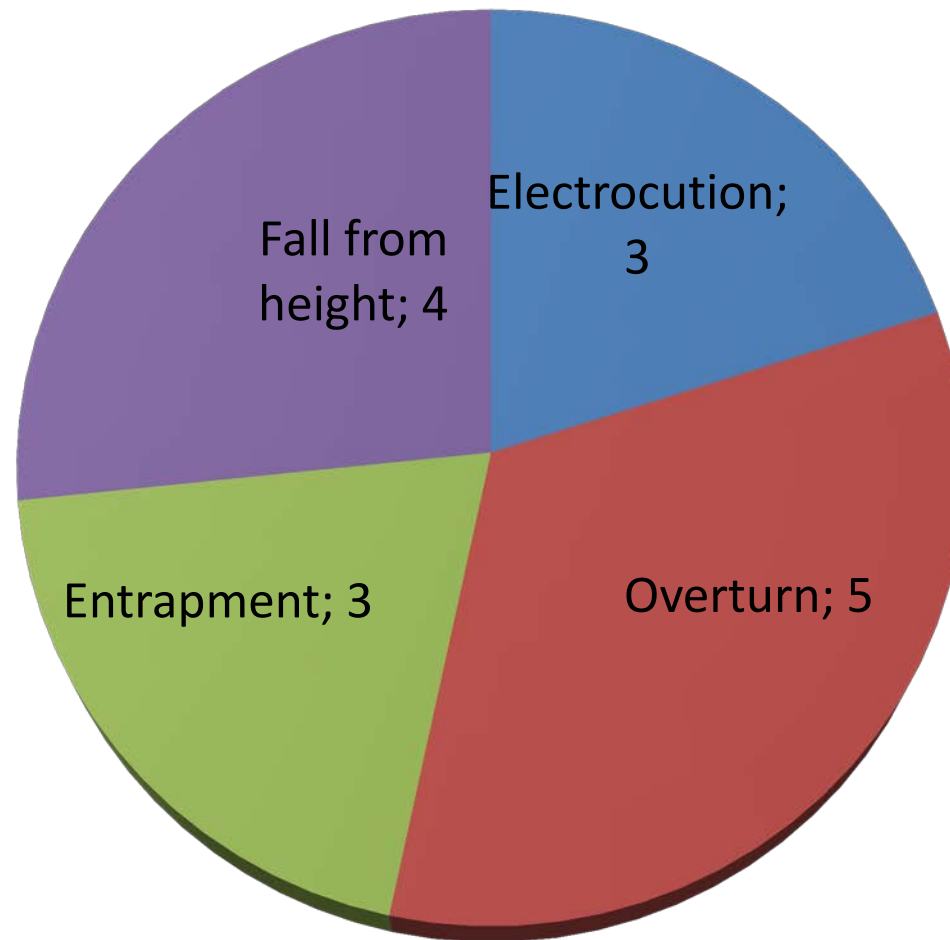

Fatalities 2013 Q2 causation



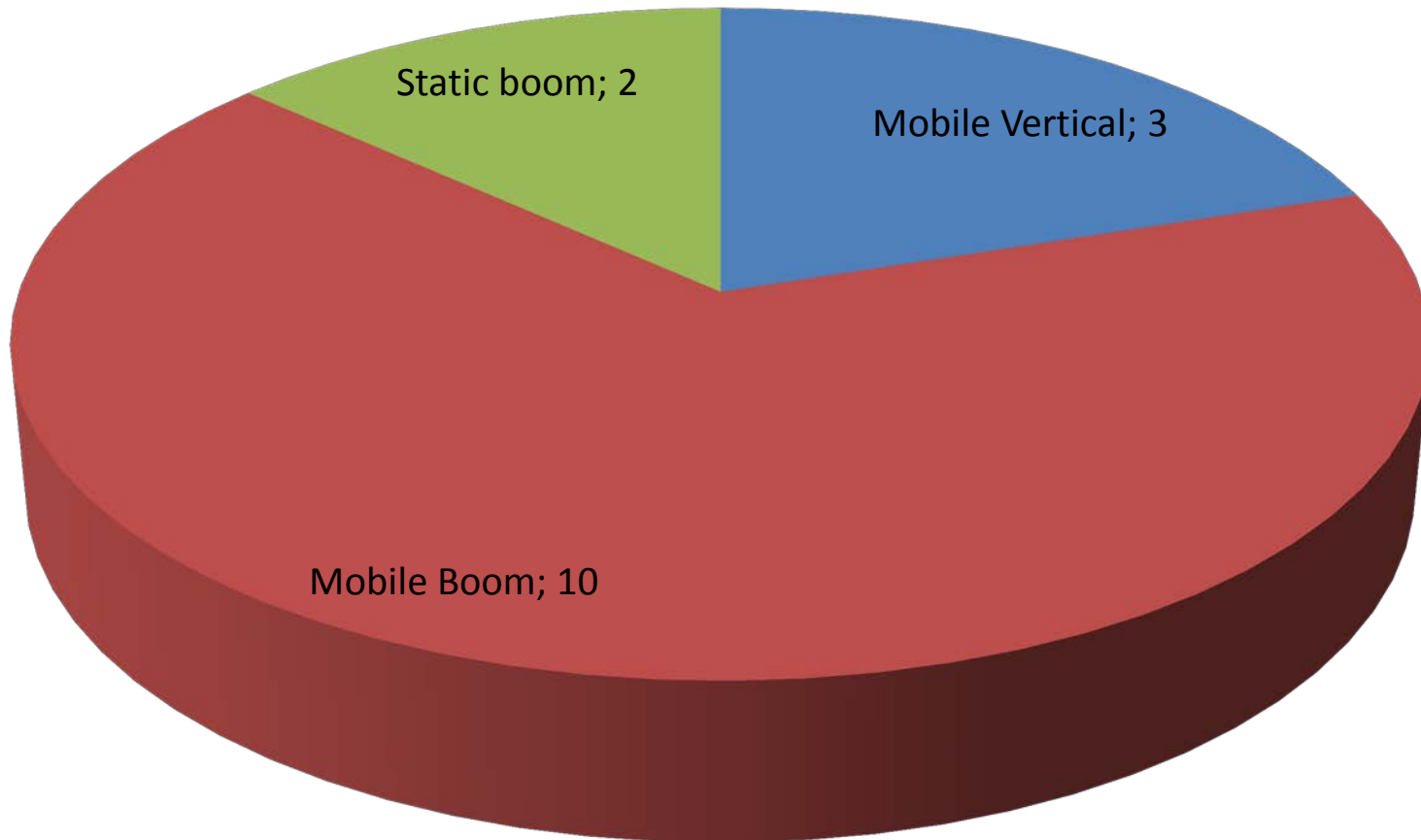

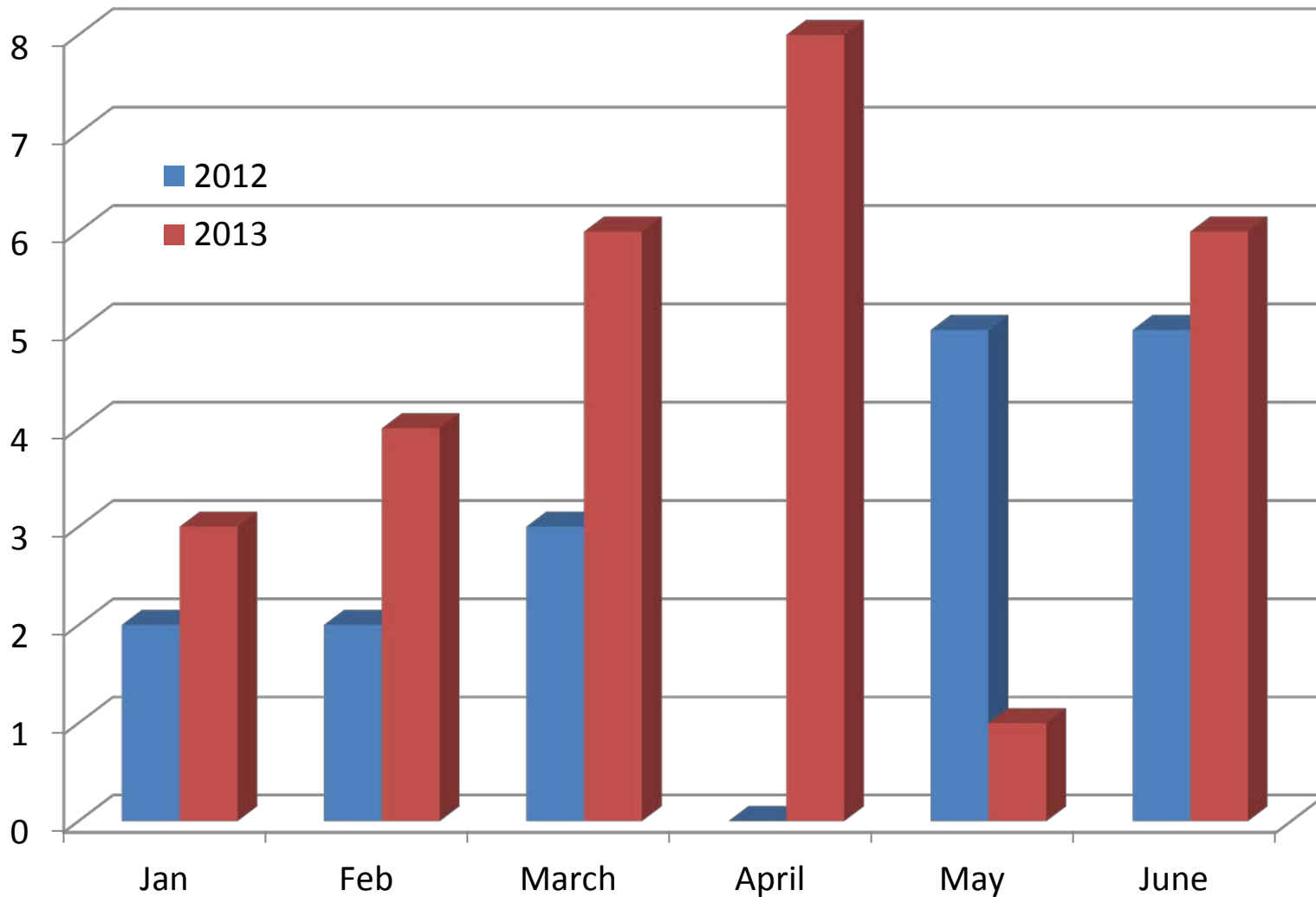
2012-2013 Half year comparison data



2012 - 2013 Fatalities per month comparison



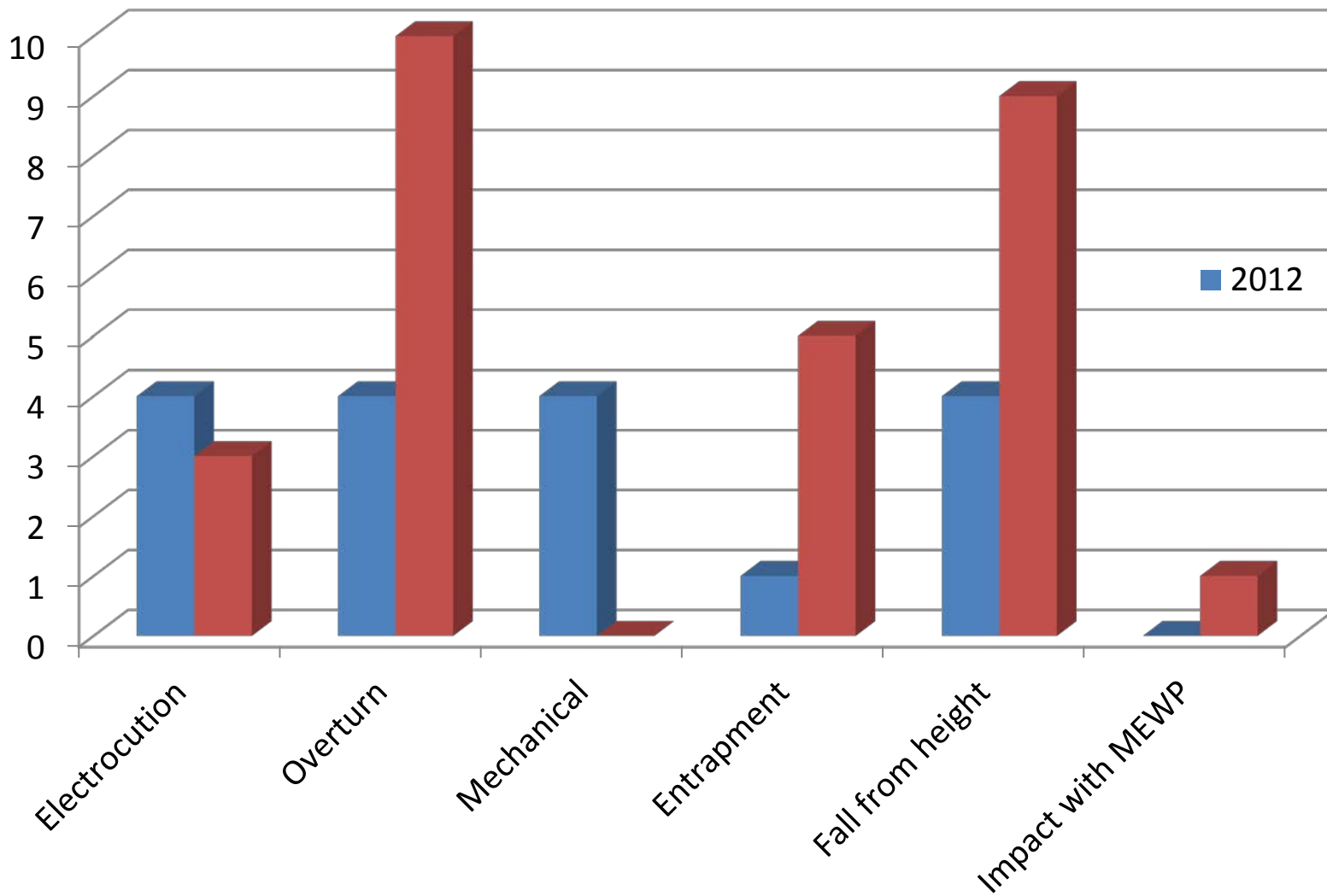

2012-2013 Fatalities causation comparison



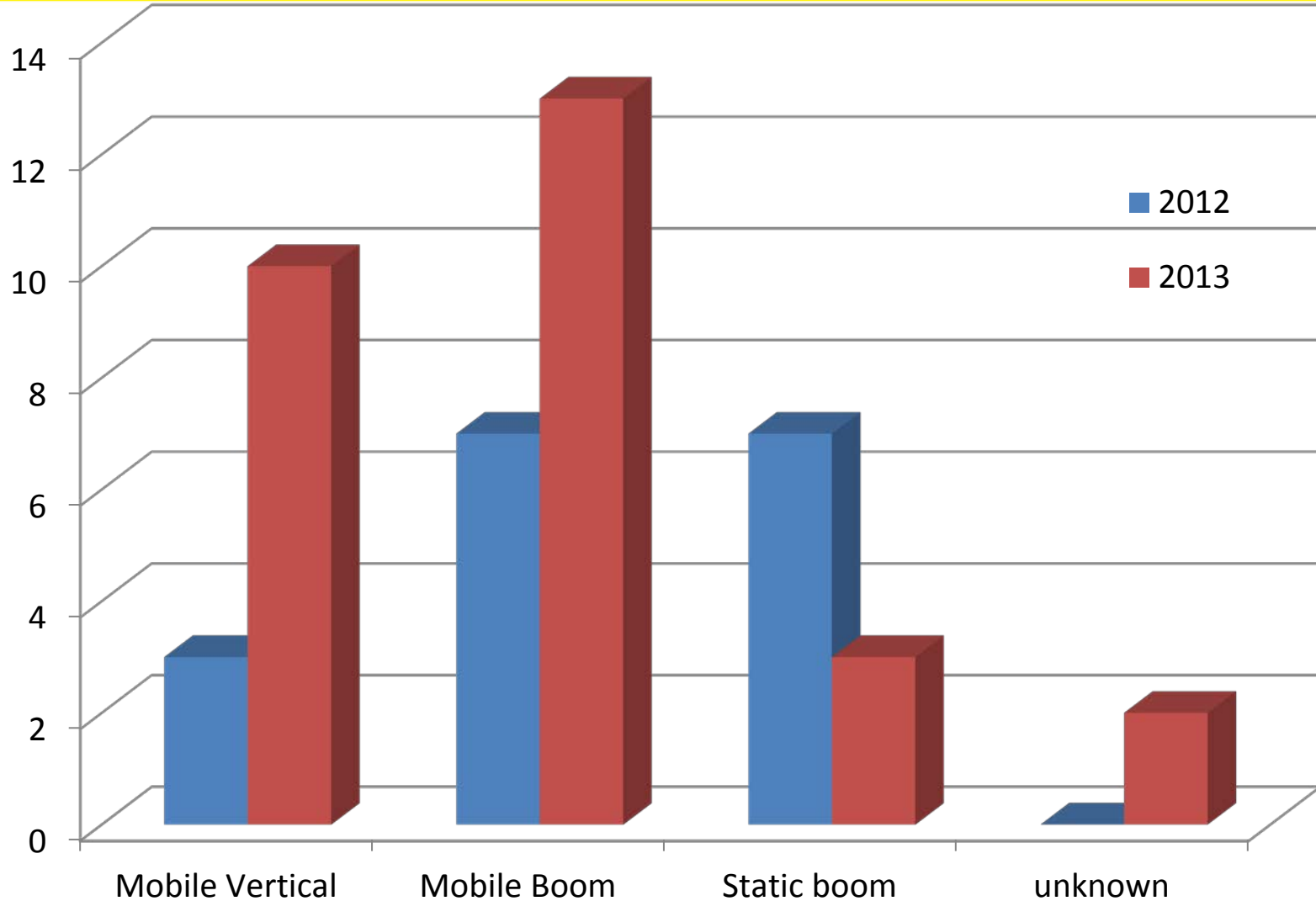

2012-2013 Fatalities m/c type comparison



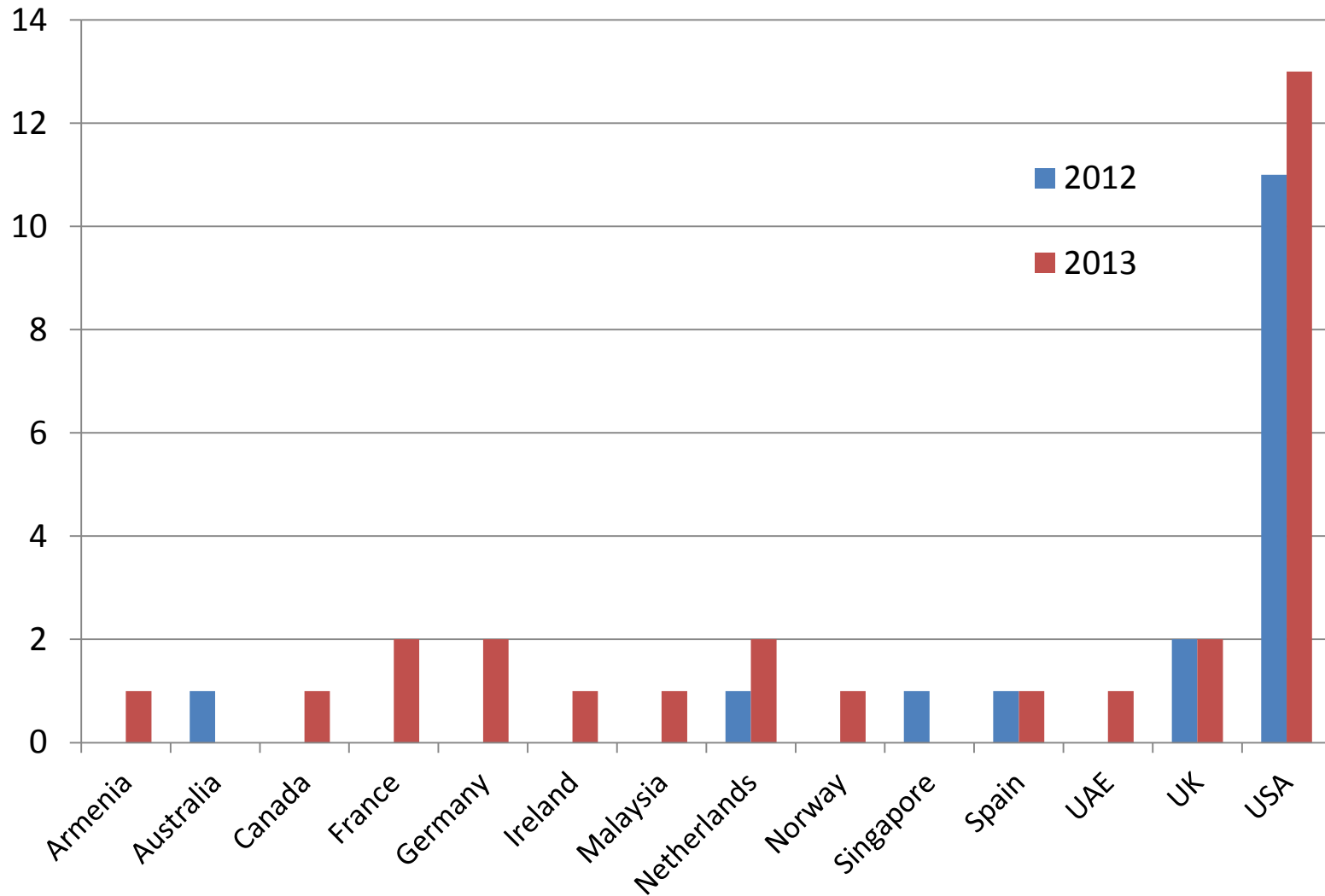
