Extended reality (*XR*) is a term referring to all real-and-virtual combined environments and human-machine interactions generated by computer technology and wearables.













CONSULTATION SURVEY RESULTS

What do you think are the advantages of using a simulator. Please tick all that apply:







CONSULTATION SURVEY RESULTS

- → 50% of the respondents had used a simulator.
- VR could be used to aid training in high-risk scenarios.
- Should not be used on its own.
- Can effectively simulate actual "operator anxiety".

IPAF believe the market would not currently accept a PAL Card being issued to an operator who had never been tested using a real machine. Do you believe that MEWP VR simulators could replace practical MEWP training in any context?*






