WHAT IS A PAL CARD?

A PAL Card is a Powered Access Licence for operating Mobile Elevating Work Platforms (MEWPs), Mast Climbing Work Platforms (MCWPs) or Construction Hoists (CHs). To qualify for a PAL Card, operators must complete an IPAF training course and pass a test at an IPAF-approved training centre. PAL Cards are issued by the International Powered Access Federation (IPAF), a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to enabling the safe and effective use of powered access worldwide.



FAQS

Who needs a PAL Card?

Anyone operating any machine category of Mobile Elevating Work Platform (MEWP), Mast Climbing Work Platform (MCWP/MMCWP) or Construction Hoist (CH).

Is there a legal requirement for training?

In most countries there is a requirement for operators to be trained before using powered access equipment.

How do I get a PAL Card?

After successful completion of training, PAL Cards are issued digitally and accessed via ePAL, IPAF's free smartphone app.

What courses are available?

How long is the training?

Courses vary from one to three days duration.

How much does it cost?

Each IPAF-approved training centre sets its own prices. Please contact your local training centre for more details.

How long is the PAL Card valid for?

Five years.

N.B. this may be subject to regional variation.

If I have a PAL Card can I use the IPAF logo?

PAL Card holders can use the 'operator tick logo' which denotes operators hold a PAL Card and have completed IPAF-approved training. Download the tick logo at www.ipaf.org/logos (search for 'operator tick logo'). Only IPAF members can use the 'IPAF Member' logo.
